WHAT TO BRING: **Your lunch and a chair.** Morning and afternoon tea is provided. Anything you might need for note taking. Please wear thick jeans and strong boots for trimming. Your horse (Full participants only) feed and feed containers. Please bring a suitable horse that is calm, used to going out and trained and physically able to lift legs and stand quietly. This means often stallions and horses under 4 are not suitable. **The length of hoof should be for a maintenance trim ie: a horse that has been getting trimmed with 3-4 weeks growth.**

PLEASE NOTE:

**CLEANING UP-
EXTRA PERSONS-**

We require you to clean up after your horse in and around the yards.

We do not encourage extra persons attending the venue ie. (drivers/strappers/children) If it is necessary, please consult with us before booking for special consideration. Waiver forms will need to be completed and some fees may be applicable.

TRIMMING TOOLS:

We have aprons and tool kits available to use at the clinic. If you have some tools bring your own. We also have a supply of **new tools** available for purchase at the clinic (see attached list). **It is best to avoid very cheap tools** as they are often hard to use and will not be sharp. Good tools make the job so much easier.

**FEES:
(GST INCLUSIVE)**

\$300 Full Participation Includes a free pair of trimming gloves, all lectures, comprehensive notes, the cadaver trim and trimming a horse under our guidance.

\$200 Auditor Includes a free pair of trimming gloves, all lectures, notes and the cadaver trim, participation in afternoon, but not trimming a horse under guidance.

**REFUND POLICY:
(\$50 NRD)**

Cancellations – all fees, less \$50, will be refunded if a medical or vet certificate is provided within seven days preceding the workshop. Alternatively, participants may transfer to another workshop if position is available. A full refund will be issued should it be necessary for a clinic to be cancelled.

TO REGISTER FOR THE WORKSHOP:

Standard Trimming Workshop Summary 8.45am – 4.30pm

- 1 Registration - Participants are issued with a booklet. Followed by a 2 hour Power Point theory session (followed by a coffee break).
- 2 Participants perform trimming on a cadaver under supervision. Lunch
- 3 Demonstration on horse handling for trimming with emphasis on safety and making the job easier.
- 4 Full participants work on their own horse's hooves, under supervision, whilst auditors observe (followed by a coffee break).
- 5 The day is rounded off with a discussion of how to grow the best possible hooves and the various options of sustainable hoof protection optimising barefoot performance.
