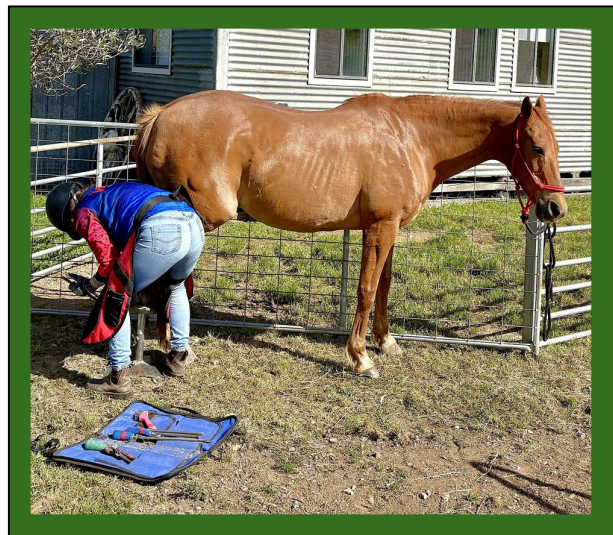
**Catering:** Tea, coffee, morning and afternoon tea provided. **BYO:** Lunch and horses' feed.

- \* Correct use of farrier tools including hoof stands.
- \* Trade secrets that make a hard job easier
- \* Latest and greatest sustainable hoof protection that does not affect hoof function (i.e. boots, tips and poly shoes)
